A 40-year-old Granite Bay resident reported his identity was stolen after an unknown individual attempted to fraudulently open a Target credit card using his identity.

James Ray Nunley II, 28, of Roseville was arrested on suspicion of burglary and violation of probation in the 9300 block of Pinehurst Drive in Roseville after a 43-year-old resident reported a burglary after finding the suspect inside the home. The suspect is alleged to have utilized the home's bathroom to shower. The suspect entered the home while the residents were upstairs and showered in a downstairs bathroom, using toiletries and making a large mess. He wasn't discovered for more than two hours. A resident chased the suspect out the front door and down the street. Deputies detained the suspect a few blocks away.

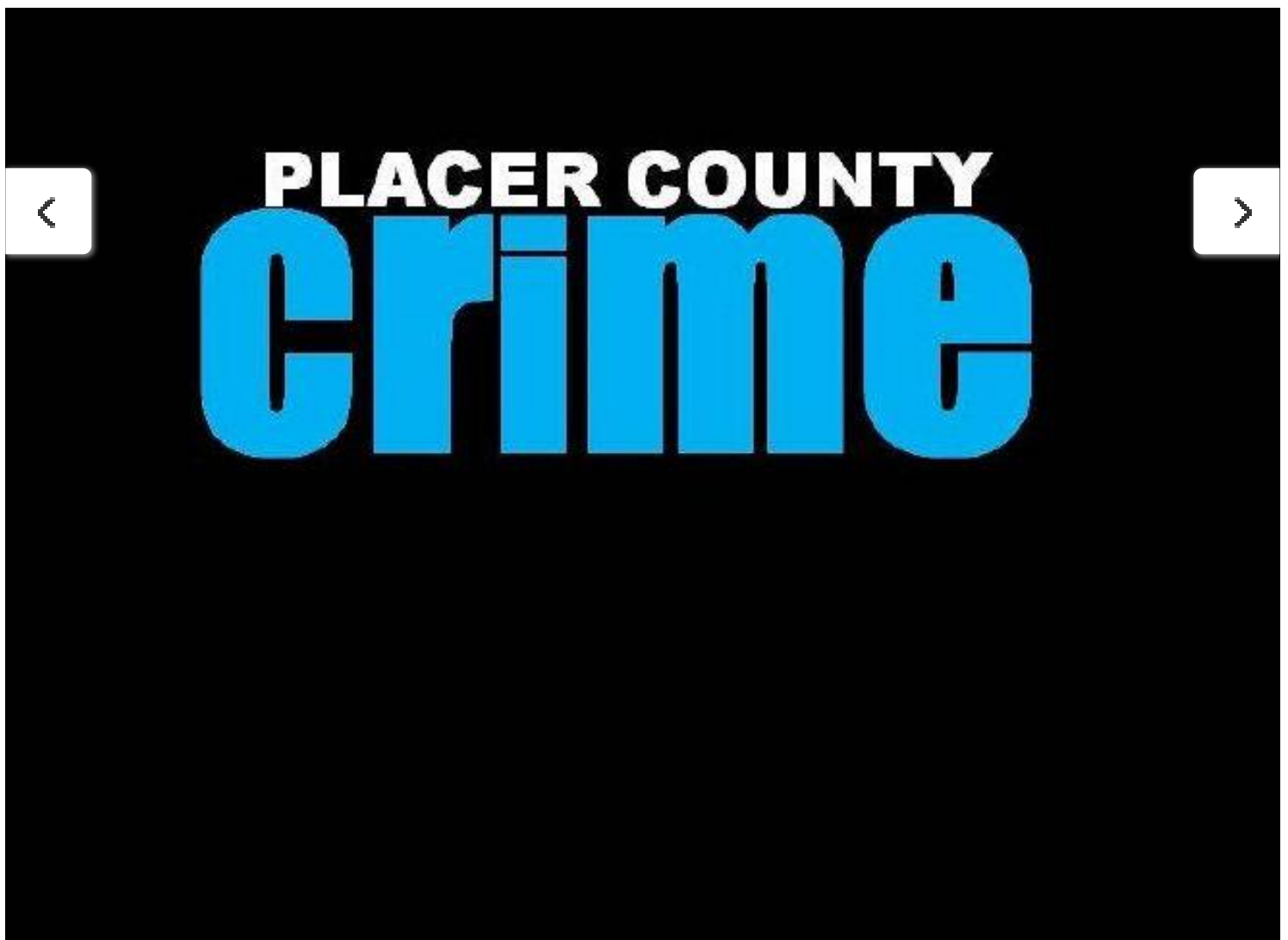
