An Elk Grove woman fell after trespassing on the Foresthill Bridge on Wednesday evening and is now sharing her photos, taken before falling, to warn others from doing the same.

An Elk Grove couple visited the bridge after seeing TikTok videos of others trespassing underneath the bridge, the Placer County Sheriff's Office reported. The woman fell off a girder from about 20 feet high.

According to Angela Musallam, public information officer for the Placer County Sheriff's Office, the woman is expected to recover from her injuries.

Last month, 20 individuals were cited for trespassing on the bridge over the course of two weeks.

According to the Sheriff's Office, the maximum fine for trespassing is \$2,000.




